If you are a Nurse Practitioner who values working as an effective team member in an inter-professional environment, this position is for you. This position assumes leadership for the Brock Geriatric Assessment Clinic (BGAC), an innovative partnership between Brock CHC, Lakeridge Health, and the Regional Geriatric Program of Toronto. BGAC focuses on quality assessment and support services to frail elderly individuals living in the community. The Ontario Telemedicine Network (OTN) is central to the service model by providing access to the expertise of a geriatrician.

Key Responsibilities:

The PCNP role emphasizes comprehensive care, health promotion and disease prevention throughout the life span. You will practice in a multifaceted role that includes clinical practice, education, consultation and research.

- Masters degree in Nursing;
- Current certification with the College of Nurses of Ontario-Extended Class;
- Certification in B.C.L.S.;

- CNA Certification in Gerontology, or intent to pursue this certification;
- Clinical experience in a hospital or community setting serving the geriatric population;

- Knowledge of the health delivery system, community and social services and the relevant legislation related to Nurse Practitioners in Ontario;
