New Physician Joins Brock CHC

Brock Community Health Centre (Brock CHC) is pleased to announce that Dr. Nabil Moharib has joined Brock CHC's Primary Health Care Program (PHCP) in Cannington on a full time basis on September 3, 2013.

Dr. Moharib received his medical training at Kharkov State Medical University in Ukraine. Most recently he has practiced medicine with Medicentres Canada from 2009 to 2013, primarily in the Calgary, Alberta area where he was a member of the Calgary Foothills Primary Care Network. He is a Certificant of the College of Family Physicians of Canada, a Licentiate of the Medical Council of Canada, and a member of the College of Family Physicians of Canada, the Ontario College of Family Physicians and the Alberta Medical Association. In addition, Dr. Moharib is a certified Hypnotherapist (Canada). He is fluent in English, Russian, Ukrainian and Arabic.

On making the announcement, Executive Director Ron Ballantyne stated: "Dr. Moharib's arrival is great news. He has valuable clinical skills and experiences that complement those already available within our primary health care interprofessional team." He added: "With Dr. Moharib, we will now be accepting new clients and increasing our services to our community".

Brock CHC's Primary Health Care Program, located at 64 Cameron St. E. in Cannington, is currently providing essential primary health care services to over 1,300 individuals and their families. Dr. Moharib is one of two full-time Family Physicians at PHCP. Other members of the team include: two Nurse Practitioners, a Registered Nurse, a full-time Social Worker, two Medical Secretaries and a Medical Receptionist.

Brock CHC began operating in 2007 as a non-profit health organization governed by a Board of Directors consisting of community representatives from across Brock Township and vicinity. Brock CHC receives funding from the Central East Local Health integration Network and the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care. The organization has a mandate to provide primary health care, diabetes education, health promotion and related health services to the residents of Brock Township and surrounding areas. Brock CHC's four programs are: Primary Health Care Program; Diabetes Education Program; Community Development and Health Promotion Program; and Brock Geriatric Assessment Clinic. In addition, funding is provided by the Ontario Trillium Foundation for two collaborative projects led by Brock CHC: the Brock Physical Activity Network; and the OTF SERA Collaborative/Community Ventures.
